Asset Register

The council owns a number of assets. The assets are listed below with some useful information. The value of all assets will be declared at each JPC AGM.

Marquee

The Marquee was purchased in 1988 for use of the Clifton Reynes and Newton Blossomville community. The marquee is free for use at charitable events. A charge is made for private hire. With the Marquee comes the trailer for transporting and the cover to protect the marquee when in the trailer.

Flooring

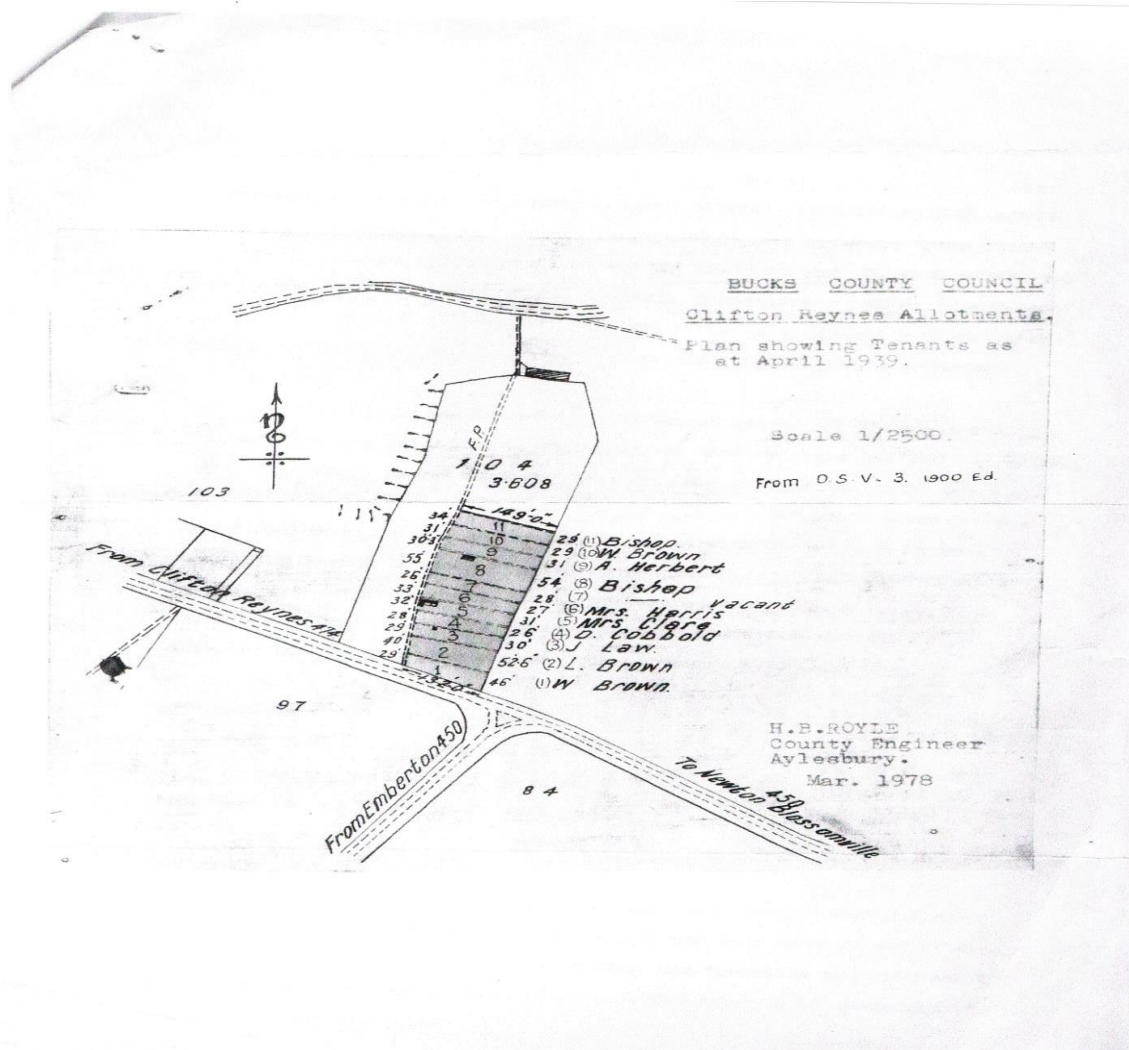
Wooden flooring is available for hire with the marquee. The flooring is not often used so an assessment will be made this year (2015) on whether to dispose of this asset.

Clifton Reynes Allotments and Adjacent Land

The allotments are for use by the Clifton Reynes and Newton Blossomville community. Allotments can be hired for a small annual fee.

The land adjacent to the allotments is for recreational use by the CR & NB community.

Dog Bins

Six dog bins are owned by the council. Three of the bins are located in NB and 3 in CR.

The NB bins are located

1. At the bottom of Hardmead Road
2. At the entrance to Millennium Field
3. On the Path down to the river adjacent to the church

The CR bins are located

4. Spring Lane next to stable
5. Church end of Church Lane at start of footpath to Olney
6. On footpath to Olney next to rear entrance Robin Hood
