Ward Councillors – National Infrastructure commission explained as there was considerable favour of increasing number of houses between Cambridge and Oxford and East West rail link, a million houses to maintain high tech firms in Cambridge, Oxford and MK. Plan MK -Includes piece of land between Junction 14 and part by Moulsoe- (Previous Land Rover Garage site) development site for further houses. Commercial planning-37 hectares warehousing at top of Chicheley Hill. Encourage everyone publicly to look at plan MK by 20th December 2017 end of consultation period.

-Budget out for consultation, grit bin, proposal not to fill them, will object, consultation ends end of Jan 18. Peter Geary will prepare a briefing note.
